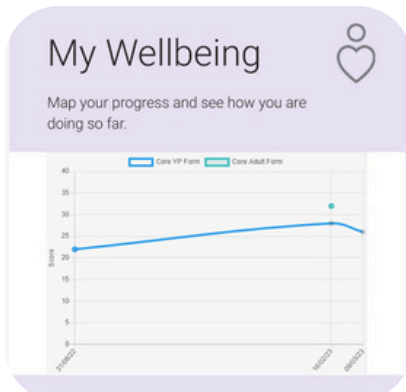
About breathe™

Evidence of service user outcomes and satisfaction

Commitment to an equality, diversity and inclusion agenda

A user-led approach to service design and delivery

Accreditation with a relevant quality standards framework depending on to the type of support being delivered

Robust safeguarding, confidentiality, data handling and business continuity policies

A commitment to continue using Breathe after year 1

Because of the capacity required to establish or expand an online service, we're keen that organisations continue to make the most of the training and infrastructure established in the first year.

In order to qualify for the fully funded first year of delivery, organisations will need to commit to using the Breathe platform for 1 further year.

You'll continue to have access to all of the benefits and support of the Breathe partnership and your bespoke Breathe platform.

The only cost involved is a license fee for the Breathe platform, with annual licences starting from £2,500
